There are numerous opportunities at HHHS to share your passion, your skills and your kind heart.

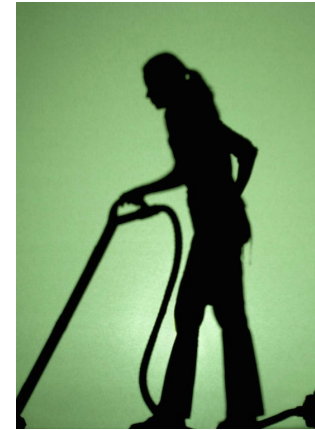
