Here for You in the Highlands Capital Campaign

In 2023, HHHSF launched a capital campaign in support of Diagnostic Imaging at HHHS, what is now the *Here for You in the Highlands* campaign. We have been overwhelmed by the support of donors and champions who have rallied behind the campaign to bring state-of-the-art Diagnostic Imaging to Haliburton County with new and upgraded services.

Kicked off by a \$500,000 transformational donation from the Cockwell Family and Haliburton Forest & Wild Life Reserve Ltd., followed by an incredible \$500,000 gift from long-time supporters Scott and Chere Campbell who also pledged to match up to \$500,000 in future donations - life-saving equipment became a reality in the County.
