### **POSITION DESCRIPTION:**

Haliburton Highlands Health Services has a permanent full time position available for an energetic and self-motivated individual wishing to join the multidisciplinary team in the role of Mental Health Counsellor/Case Manager, to provide intervention, assessment, treatment and case management services to individuals and their families with serious Mental Health and Addictions related conditions. In addition, this position is responsible for the overall care coordination and provision of mental health interventions for youth experiencing first episode of psychosis within the Early Psychosis Intervention (EPI) Program. Case Manager services include assertive outreach, screening and assessment, service planning and evaluation, consultation with other service providers, and crisis intervention to support stabilization and recovery. The successful candidate will be a member of the HHHS Mental Health Program.

### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Minimum of a Bachelor's Degree in Social Work; a Master's Degree would be an asset;
- Minimum 3 years related mental health clinical experience in a community setting working with youth and/or adults who suffer with serious mental health and addiction related conditions;
- Registration with the appropriate professional College or organization required (Registered Social Worker or Registered Psychotherapist);
- Comprehensive understanding of both regional and rural service delivery issues;
- Valid driver's license, automobile in good repair and required insurance coverage.
- Ability to work in a client's living, learning and working environment;
- Demonstrated ability to work autonomously as well as collaboratively within a team environment;
- Strong workload management skills to respond to multi-faceted and competing demands;
- Working knowledge of relevant legislation (Mental Health Act, etc.) and collateral service system;
